### **Greetings from NIS!**

Please be informed of following

**Parents Teachers Meeting:** First of all, hearty appreciation to those parents who attended the PTM on 10<sup>th</sup> November. However, a few parents have not attended any PTM until now, which is not good for the academic growth of children. We have listed the name of those parents and we wish to see them at least for the next meeting without fail. Hope you oblige.

Regarding the suggestions given by the parents during the last two PTMs, the following measures have been taken:


- **School Transport:** We are keeping track of the school bus arrival on day to day basis and we have seen considerable improvement in their arrival time. We are happy to inform you that all the school buses are reaching the school before 7.20 am. Similarly, we will keep track of timings of parent as well as private transport users. Kindly co-operate with us to ensure that the students reach at the right time to the school. Dropping the children late to the school is not allowed. Secondly, all the school bus drivers are warned strictly to be mindful of the language that they use in front of students. The drivers are instructed not to be rude.
- **Weight of the School Bag:** Students are given the facility of using the lift to carry the bags. Maids are available both at the arrival and at the dispersal time to help in this task. Teachers clearly inform the students what books to be brought. Therefore, students must learn to arrange their bags at home **according to the timetable**.
- **Discipline:** Let there be no misunderstanding in the mind of parents that children of a particular nationality is favored more than the other children. Let us not spread this kind of **negative thinking**. If any parent still feels the same kindly contact the principal with more details at the earliest.
- **Attention for the weak children:** There were concerns from the parents of a few new admissions that the students are not getting "much" from the school in grade 1. Please understand that due to

Corona break many students in grade 1 are lagging behind in their writing skills and grasping power. During the admission time a few parents took a wise decision of admitting their children for one grade lower than the actual and therefore not facing any problem/ stress regarding the studies of their kids. The other parents need not regret or be stressed too much. The students will pick up the speed. Have patience. Our teachers will not ignore them. If still not satisfied, please contact the principal with specific details so that we can help you better.

- **Canteen:** There were complaints regarding the canteen. Please be assured that **only those items approved by the Ministry of Health** will be sold in the canteen and no other stuff. At the same time, we request the parents to send healthy home cooked food in the tiffin box instead of making it a habit for the students to go to canteen regularly. Please be informed that canteen facility is not extended to students of KG, grade 1 and 2 as they cannot handle the money independently. Only occasionally and only with the help of teacher they can visit the canteen.
- **Reading skills:** To improve the reading skills of children we are allowing the students to borrow books from library with immediate effect. However, students should take care of books issued, if a book is lost, misused or wrongly handled, students have to replace the book or pay the current market price of the book.
- **Mask:** There were suggestions to make mask compulsory. Please be informed that we can't do that. However, we can request the parents to keep their children at home during the period of sickness. This will minimize the spread of diseases. Hope you understand and help us to help you better.

Please be assured that each and every suggestion given by the parents in the best interest of the students will be viewed seriously.
