We hope all of you must have enjoyed with your kids during the summer break. Now, as the school reopens on 29-8-23 it's our pleasure to welcome kids back to school. Kindly start getting the kids ready for the school. Every child faces challenges while heading back to school. This can be little more difficult for the kids of the primary school, as the school environment demands many things, such as ability to sit still, get organized, stay on task, adapt to a structured schedule etc. Therefore, both the parents and the teachers need to work hard and plan well to make their life easy and smooth in the school. Our staff members are already excited to welcome the students. They are preparing a series of engaging and challenging learning experiences for all the students, They are also undergoing training to make the classes more interesting and interactive. We look forward to the same level of enthusiasm from the parents and the students as well. Kindly take note of the following:

- Kindly check if your ward is ready with his/her "Holiday Assignments". If kids haven't completed, be next to them until they complete the same.
- Secondly ensure that atleast from today onwards they commence the reading and the writing practice daily for an hour so that they will get used to the same before the school reopens.
- Kindly check the "exhibits/models" that your child has prepared for the "Exhibition" that is coming up. If your ward has not prepared any exhibit, motivate the child to prepare the same. Participation in the extracurricular activities will undoubtedly boost the morale of the children.

- Children should be greeted with a smile when they enter the school premises. They should not be stopped at the gate for being late, Therefore start early from home as traffic is a known devil to all of us. Those who are using the school transport/ private transport check with the transporter the previous day and confirm the pickup time, to avoid morning rush.
- Ask your kids to find their uniform, the **right colored** shoes, socks, hair bands, clips etc. Don't teach them to break the rules.
- Check the hairstyle of the children and if they are still in the "funky "hairstyle of the summer, kindly restore the normal style before they are questioned in the school. Spare the child from those embarrassing moments.
- Ask the kids to pack their bags neatly with the required stationary and books, so that they need not have to borrow from others.
- Pack interesting but healthy food items in the tiffin box to make their break time a real fun time.
- The first day of the school, the dispersal maybe slightly delayed. Please be patient and cooperate with us.
- Lastly and more importantly, please be assured that your children are safe and loved in the school; Make your children understand the same, so that they will come to school happily.
