Please take note of the following:

- **Field Trip:** We are happy to inform you that a Field trip has been organized for the students of grade **3 & 4** on 20th November. They will visit the **Fire Station** and understand the technicalities of how a Fire station works. It is free of cost.
 - i) Students need to be in perfect uniform. The reporting and dispersal time will remain the same as usual.
 - ii) Wearing of the I.D card is compulsory.
 - iii) The consent slip must be deposited with the class teacher.
 - iv) The students need to conduct themselves in a well disciplined manner during the visit to ensure their own safety as well to uphold the honour of New Indian School.
- **Children's day celebration:** Every year on 14th November, we celebrate Children's day to celebrate the birthday of **Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru**, the first Prime Minister of India. However, this year, we don't have elaborate celebrations. Therefore, 14th November will be a regular day.
